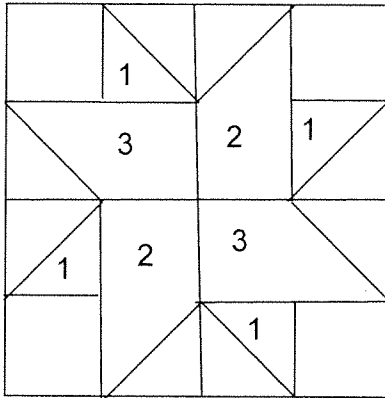


Thunder Bay Quilters' Guild 2009-2010 Block of the Month

BOM #6



Corners (BG) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ – need 4

Half Square Rectangles:
(BG) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ – need 4

(color 2) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ – need 2

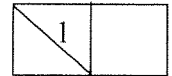
(color 3) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ – need 2

Half Square Triangles:
(color 1) $3\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$ – need 2

(BG) $3\frac{1}{4}'' \times 3\frac{1}{4}''$ – need 2

1. Make the 4 half square triangles using the $3\frac{1}{4}''$ BG and color 1. Square up to $2\frac{1}{2}''$

2. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}''$ BG corner square to one edge so it looks like this picture.
Make 4. Press to the corner square

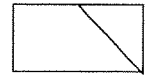


Making the half square rectangles:

3. Lightly draw a diagonal line on the back of the 4 remaining $2\frac{1}{2}''$ BG squares.

4. Place it right sides together on one end of the $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangle.
So it looks like the picture.

5. Sew on the line. Press to rectangle. Then trim excess. Make 2 of each color.



6. Sew a unit from step 2 to each of the half square rectangles.

7. Sew the 4 blocks together to look like the block picture. Pressing seams so they will interlock.

8. It should measure $8\frac{1}{2}''$ square
