

## MODERN LOG CABIN

### CUTTING

Centre:  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Borders: Two  $2$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " and two  $2$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " from **each** of two fabrics (8 pieces total)

Accent strip:  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide by  $46$ " + total (pieced end to end or plain). Cut two  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " and two  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " segments from the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Following the picture, make 4 border units (two  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " long and two  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " long), using one of each border fabric with an accent strip in the middle.



Assemble the top starting with a partial seam. (Seam one long strip to the center, aligning the ends. Stop stitching  $1$ " or more before the end of the centre piece.) Add the next three segments around the centre as pictured. Complete the initial partial seam. Layer, quilt, add label and bind.
