

Bags, Bags, Bags

Materials

- Main fabric, lining and batting
- Zipper

***the amount of fabric required is determined by the size you want to make**

Directions

1. Cut a rectangle, any size you want to make the bag the size you want from the main fabric, lining and batting.
2. Quilt the main fabric with batting on the back.
3. Sew the zipper, using a zipper foot to the right side of the main fabric with the teeth of the zipper away from the edge. Repeat for the other side.
4. With right sides together, sew the lining to the zipper edge.
5. Flip the lining to the inside of the tube, Press the area around the zipper. Top stitch along the zipper edge on the right side of main fabric.
6. Prepare a pull tab for the zipper area. (I used a 2"x 3 ½" piece of fabric).
7. Place tab between the lining and main fabric and sew end seam. Repeat for the other end.
8. Sew corners to shape the end of the bag.
