

## NO TWO ALIKE

(9) coordinating 8" squares – **makes two placemats**

Lay out the squares and assemble into a nine-patch block. Make two parallel cuts across the nine-patch, unequally spaced. Shift/offset the sections randomly and re-stitch. Decide on the orientation for your 12 ½" x 18 ½" placemat and trim excess in one direction. Add to the unit you are building. Continue in this manner until you have a large enough piece to trim to 12 ½" x 18 ½". Keep it simple without cutting the pieces too small, and you will have enough remaining to assemble into another placemat using the same method. Layer, quilt, add label and bind.
