Ana Paula Brasil is an international artist and designer with a background in fine arts. She has travelled the world teaching textile art and her passion for teaching is contagious. Ana Paula will share her knowledge, high energy and creativity with us in this 2023 Christmas Workshop.



Purchase of pattern will be required for this workshop and can be purchased for \$7 (Pattern purchase to be paid to tbqg with Registration). In this one day workshop, you will have the amazing opportunity to create a stunning Christmas table setting to host your family and friends.

Ana Paula will guide you through two different techniques, appliqué as well as foundation paper piecing. Using foundation blocks will enable you to adapt the project to your table size as well as to the number of place settings. During this workshop you will make a table runner, placemats, cloth napkins with mitred corners, cutlery mittens as well as charger plate covers! This is a workshop you won't want to miss!



Basic techniques in fabric selection, cutting, piecing, and binding will be taught as well as differences in batting, thread and backing fabrics.

A variety of blocks based on four patch & variations, nine patch, log cabin, rail fence and star blocks will have you making a set of placemats complete with binding and walking foot quilting.

While designed for those with no quilting experience, this introduction class works well for those who are looking for tips and techniques to enhance their skills and increase their accuracy in piecing.

The Introduction to Quilting will be followed with Skill Building Sessions that will strengthen your quilting skills as you continue your journey into the wonderful world of guilting.
