

## EAST OR WEST?

- (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " – flying geese centres
- (8)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " – flying geese sides & (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " – corners of centre square
- (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " – centre square
- (2)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " – background



Mark a diagonal line on each  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make 4 flying geese by adding 2 corners (position, sew on the line, trim seam allowance underneath) to each flying geese centre. Add 4 corners to the centre square in the same manner. Lay out with background fabrics as pictured and sew together. Layer, quilt, add label and bind.
