

## PINWHEEL CORNERS

Inner border: (2)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ "

Background: (2)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ "

Centre square: (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ "

Corners of centre square: (4)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Pinwheels: (8) light  $3$ " x  $3$ " and (8) dark  $3$ " x  $3$ "



Mark a diagonal line on each light pinwheel square. Pair light and dark  $3$ " squares right sides together. Make 16 half-square triangles (HSTs) by sewing  $\frac{1}{4}$ " each side of the marked line, cutting on the line and then squaring up to  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Mark a diagonal line on each  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Position one on each corner of the centre square, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim excess fabric from underneath. Lay out as pictured and sew together. Layer, quilt, add label and bind.
